Multi-Model Decision Card — Worked Example

DECISION I'M SITTING ON

Should I hire an associate dentist this quarter, or wait until I've validated the growth from our new marketing spend?

MY 4-MODEL PLAN

1 IDEATE — CLAUDE

"I'm a solo GP in a growing market. Revenue up 22% YoY. Considering hiring an associate. Build me a framework for evaluating this decision — what factors matter, in what order, and what a good answer looks like."

3 REFINE — CLAUDE

"Here's the critique. Rewrite the framework, integrate the pushback. Show me a version 2 that answers the sharpest criticisms."

2 CRITIQUE — CHATGPT

"Here's Claude's framework. Play a skeptical dental practice consultant. What's this framework missing? What are the failure modes I'm not seeing?"

4 STRESS TEST — GROK

"Given this framework, what's the worst-case scenario if I hire? What's the worst-case if I wait? What am I emotionally biased toward that's clouding my judgment?"

DECIDE BY

September 15, 2026

STILL UNCERTAIN ABOUT

Whether our new-patient flow is durable or a marketing sugar-high. Talk to our marketing partner.

SUCCESS LOOKS LIKE

By December, I know if we can sustain 40 additional new patients/mo. Yes → hire January. No → I've saved myself a \$200K mistake.

THE 4-WEEK RULE

WEEK 1 · AUG 9–15

Run the 4-model workflow. **First pass** through all four steps.

WEEK 2 · AUG 16–22

Show the framework to your team. Get their input. What did the models miss?

WEEK 3 · AUG 23–29

Refine based on team feedback. Run any model again if needed.

WEEK 4 · AUG 30–SEP 5

Make the decision. Or explicitly decide to wait — with a date attached to the wait.

IF YOU GET STUCK

- Go back to Session B's framework: **Ideate** → **Critique** → **Refine** → **Stress-test** → **Decide**.
- Ask: "What's the smallest version of this decision I can make first, to **buy myself information**?"
- Make THAT decision. Not the perfect version. The information-buying version.
